It is a great way to spot undesirable accounts, and best of all, it's FREE!

This exclusive membership benefit gives real-time reporting with zero wait time for printed reports each month. It also gives members the ability to check back or update into the database as often as they want.

The program is built on strict confidentiality through written Credit Reporting Service Agreement between the Association and the participating company. Accordingly, SlowPay is available for authorized Association members only, not available to the general public, or members that have not completed the Credit Reporting Service Agreement.
